The Anna Leonowens Gallery (The Anna) has hosted over 4600 exhibitions and projects to date in its 52-year history. A unique exhibition space, The Anna's pedagogical mandate is to equip emerging artists and curators with hands-on, practical experience. Participants in the course will benefit from the personal experience of the instructors, both practitioners in the gallery field as well as a roster of professional Canadian artists.

The ALG Certificate in Gallery and Studio Management is a series of 5 online professional development workshops for emerging artists and gallery workers, which may be taken on an individual basis or together as part of the ALG Certificate. This series is designed to provide the practical skills necessary and essential to succeeding in navigating a career as a professional artist or arts worker. To obtain the ALG Certificate all courses must be completed and participants are evaluated on a competency basis based on understanding of the material presented and completion of assignments.
