


Colour Your Art

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This week BoxTown launched into space! The world they created was full of restaurants, spaceship, and moon rock stores. Together they built a little world to play in all week amongst the stars!












This week they learnt the province song, made so much letter related art and played lots of games.








Ceramics




Portraits
